1. **Used book(s) of your choice:** Make sure you're upcycling trash, not destroying a valuable book, magazine, catalog, etc. Session 1 - I will provide a choice of books for your use and will present the different kinds of books to best fit your concept/theme.

2. **Materials:** You may bring 2D items in a small box, folders, envelopes, etc. These may include photos, magazine images/words, old calendars, gardening/other catalogs, hand-written pages, decorative paper, tissue paper, memorabilia, ephemera, lettering, colorful paper napkins, lace/doilies, stamps, stickers, favorite quotes, etc. Small 3D items can also be incorporated, such as dried flowers, beads, ribbons, buttons, small toys, etc.

3. **Art supplies:** Session 1 - we will provide a variety of mediums for you to try out. You are welcome to bring what you have, such as pencils, colored pencils, pens, markers, watercolors, craft paints, crayons, oil pastel, glitter, glue, etc.

4. **Other supplies and tools (optional):** White glue dispenser, UHU glue stick, hole punch, small fine scissors, stamps/stamp pads, distressing ink, stencils, etc.
